

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW # 30 - 2023

Being a by-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers
for the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne

WHEREAS Section 15(1) of the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 15*, as amended, authorizes Municipal Councils to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 15(2) of the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 15*, designates Municipal Law Enforcement Officers are Peace Officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS Section 227 of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001*, authorizes Councils to pass by-laws for appointing such officers and employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the Corporation, for carrying into effect the provisions of any by-law of the Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne enacts as follows:

1. THAT the persons identified in Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming part of this By-law, be and are hereby appointed Municipal Law Enforcement Officers and shall enforce the by-laws of the municipality and shall be peace officers for the purpose of enforcing said municipal by-laws;
2. THAT the said Municipal Law Enforcement Officers shall also be officers assigned the responsibility of administering and enforcing any by-laws passed under Section 15.1 of the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, c.23, as amended, with respect to property standards matters;
3. THAT the said Municipal Law Enforcement Officers shall perform such other duties as may be required of them from time to time;
4. THAT Municipal Law Enforcement Officer exercising a power of entry may:
 - a) Require production for inspection of documents or things relevant to an inspection;
 - b) Inspect and remove documents or things relevant to an inspection for the purpose of making copies or extracts;
 - c) Require information from any person concerning a matter related to an inspection; and
 - d) Alone or in conjunction with a person possessing special or expert knowledge, make examinations or take tests, samples or photographs necessary for the purposes of an inspection.
5. THAT By-laws #48-2016, #49-2016, #59-2018, #36-2020 and #21-2022 are hereby repealed.
