Thank you for your correspondence informing me of Shelburne Council's June 14, 2021 resolution supporting the resolution from the County of Dufferin regarding Residential Schools. I appreciate you taking the time to keep me informed on Council's initiatives and activities.

The legacy of Residential Schools is a national shame that's had a profoundly lasting and damaging impact on Indigenous culture, heritage, and language. The discovery of the mass grave at a former Residential School in Kamloops, B.C. is a somber reminder that so much more work needs to be done to address the devastating and harmful effects that Residential Schools had, and still have, on many survivors today.

My Conservative colleagues and I are calling on Canada's Parliament to share in our commitment to reconciliation, and for the federal government to take immediate action to address this unspeakable discovery, and support the Indigenous communities and our country, in mourning.

Thank you again for bringing this resolution to my attention and for your continued work to serve the residents of Shelburne.
