Recommendation

Be it Resolved that Council of the Town of Shelburne:

- 1. Receives the report DO2021-07 "Asphalt Resurfacing 2021 RFP Results" from the Director of Development and Operations dated August 23, 2021, as presented and circulated; and that
- 2. Aecon Construction and Materials Limited be awarded the 2021 contract for Hot Mix Asphalt Resurfacing of Municipal Roads with an upset limit of \$275,842 HST inclusive to match the \$260,842 OCIF grant plus the 2021 budgeted amount of \$15,000 for laneway resurfacing

Background

The Town's Road Needs Study was updated in Spring 2020. The update reprioritized road sections that have been rehabilitated and sections that have further deteriorated since the 2015 study.

Report Director, Development and Operations DO2021-07

Analysis

The 2021 RFP for Asphalt Resurfacing was distributed to eleven contractors on July 9th and closed July 29, 2020. Four submissions were received from Aecon Construction and Materials Limited, Coco Paving Inc, The Murray Group and Cox Construction. These companies have worked for the Town in the past and have very good reputations in the industry.

The review of the bids was completed by SBA with the recommendation that the Town accept the submission from Aecon Construction and Materials Ltd being the lowest quoted bid. The Summary of Bids dated August 12, 2021, from SBA is provided in Appendix 1.

The RFP included a list of streets listed in the Roads Needs Study. These projects have been budgeted for in 2021 to be funded through OCIF.

Staff did include a number of projects in the RFP to ensure that the Town had quotes to cover the full OCIF funding amount. The total quoted by Aecon for the RFP listed projects does exceed our available funding.

The RFP does allow the Town to delete and adjust project items in order to come within budgeted amounts.

Staff suggests deleting the Second Avenue East cost, item 1c included in the RFP to match the funds available for 2021.

Financial Impact

The 2021 budgeted amount for OCIF was estimated to be \$262,000. The actual 2021 OCIF funding amount is \$260,842.00. The 2021 budgeted amount for annual back lane resurfacing is \$15,000. (line 01-2501-7570)

Combined total being \$275,842.00n inclusive of HST.

Aecon Construction and Materials Limited estimate for was \$279,535.00 pretax or 284,454.81 HST inclusive. Staff will adjust the scope of the work to match the available budget of \$275,842.00

S. Burnett & Associates Limited (SBA) has prepared the following letter to summarize the bids received from Contractors regarding the Town of Shelburne, Hot Mix Asphalt Resurfacing of Municipal Roads 2021 Project. The Request for Proposal (RFP) document was delivered via email directly to a list of local contractors on July 9, 2021. A total of 11 Contractors were forwarded the Request for Proposal.

- Kings Valley Paving Inc.
- Coco Paving Inc.
- The Miller Group
- Positano Paving
- The Murray Group Ltd.
- Aecon Construction and Materials Ltd.
- Georgian Paving Ltd.
- Roto-Mill Inc.
- Cox Construction Ltd.
- Edwards Excavating & Construction

A non-mandatory, but highly recommended Contractor's site visit was held on Thursday, July 15, 2021, at 10:00 am with representatives from the following three (3) contractors in attendance: Cox Construction Ltd., Aecon Construction and Materials Ltd., and The Murray Group Ltd.

Only one (1) addendum was issued throughout the RFP process that addressed questions by the Contractors and additional clarifications.

Four (4) bids were received by the closing date of July 29, 2021, at 3:00 p.m. local time. All bid submissions were sent via email to Carey Holmes, Treasurer, Town of Shelburne. The bids were received from the following Contractors:

- Aecon Construction and Materials Ltd.
- Coco Paving Inc.

- The Murray Group Ltd.
- Cox Construction Ltd.

Table 1 below presents the initial bid summaries received from the four (4) Contractors.

SBA has checked the submissions for mathematical errors and found none.

All Contractors provided the required Agreement to Bond along with signed acknowledgement of Addendum No. 1 as per the RFP requirements. SBA would consider all submissions to be compliant.

SBA completed a pre-Proposal cost estimate for all items within the RFP and projected a cost of approximately \$263,500.00 (excluding HST) to complete all work including Provisional Items. All four (4) contractors submitted bids higher than this estimate, with Aecon, Coco Paving and Cox Construction being within 15%. Overall Aecon came in lowest at \$279,535.00. With Items 1 - 6 of this project being Provisional, the Town may choose to reduce the scope of work in order to fit within the available budget.

Aecon has satisfactorily completed similar projects in the past for the Town of Shelburne and for SBA. They are well known throughout the Dufferin and Wellington County area and have experience completing similar resurfacing projects. SBA would consider this company capable of completing the Hot Mix Asphalt Resurfacing of Municipal Roads project with positive results.

The Town's Hot Mix Asphalt Resurfacing of Municipal Roads budget for 2021 before applicable tax is \$256,330.58, based on the Town's annual OCIF funding allocation. There is also a separate budgeted amount from the Municipal Operating Budget of \$14,740.56 before applicable tax, that will cover Item 6: Laneway (south of Main Street). Therefore, a total pretax budget of \$271,071.14 has been allocated for this year's program.

Aecon's bid for Items 1-7, comes to a total of \$279,535.50 pre HST. Understanding this, SBA proposes the following scope of work be awarded, however this is only one scenario and further discussions with The Town should be completed prior to finalization:

- Item 1 Second Street: (William Street to Owen Sound Street) excluding Item 1c
- Item 2 Robert Street: (William Street to Owen Sound Street)
- Item 3 James Street North: (Foodland Entrance to First Avenue)
- Item 4 Sarah Court
- Item 5 Andrew Street: (James Street to Dufferin Street)
- Item 6 Laneway: (South of Main Street, from Jelly Street to Dufferin Street)
- Item 7 Allowances.

Item 1c: full depth asphalt removal and replacement: Second Avenue East at a cost of \$10,803.00 is recommended for postponement due the unit price being significantly higher then expected for this work.

Under this recommended scope of work, Aecon Materials and Construction Ltd. remains the most competitive submission, at a total cost of \$268,732.50, which is within the 2021 OCIF plus operating budget requirements. Additional modifications to the scope of work, including a reduction in proposed works on Robert Street can be pursued, if desired by the Town.

Therefore, should the Town of Shelburne consider moving forward with this project, SBA would recommend the Proposal submission from Aecon for a total of \$268,732.50 excluding HST, be considered. A copy of the bid submissions from all Contractors have been included for your review and information.

Pending acceptance of this recommendation, SBA would recommend a meeting with Town staff to prioritize the seven (7) awarded items and ensure a scope of work that is within the budget. SBA would then proceed with appropriate notification and Contract award notice to Aecon Materials and Construction Ltd.

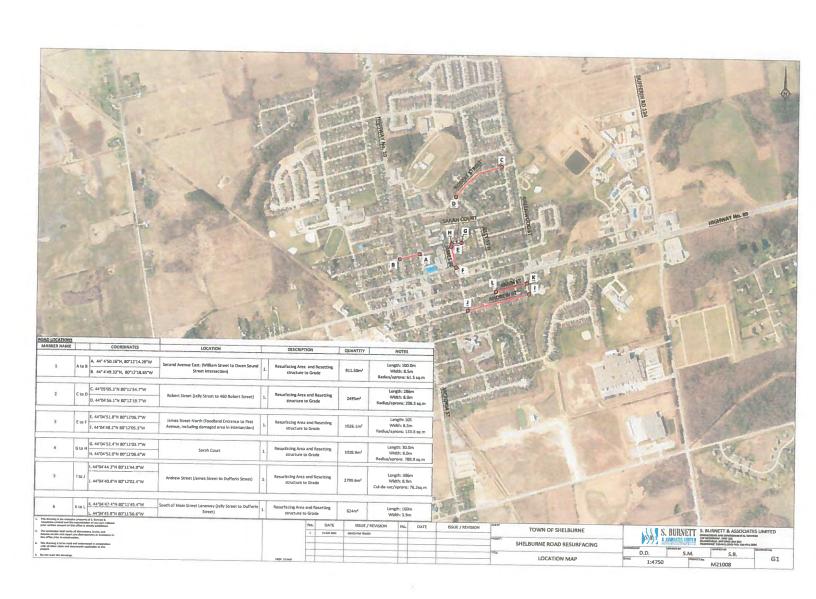

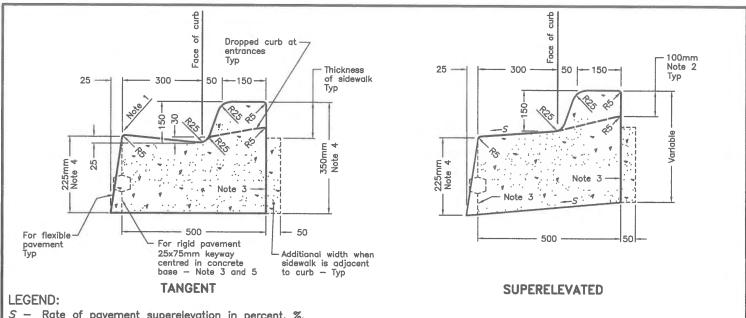
Location Map

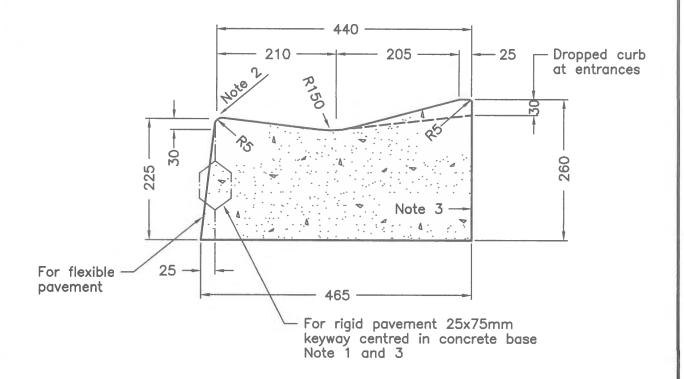

1. General Information to Contractors:

- 2. Bidders are to note that the Town of Shelburne has first right of refusal for all materials, specifically asphalt grindings.
- 3. Bidders shall REMOVE AND REPLACE page 19 of 29 of the Schedule of Unit Prices with the attached.

QUESTIONS AND REPSONSES

- Question 1: Do we only need to submit, along with the tender, an Agreement to Bond showing 100% for both Labour and Material and Performance? Or do you need a Bid Bond as well? If so, what percent do we need to show on the BB?
- Response 1: Only an Agreement to Bond is required.
- Question 2: Will there be a bid security required to accompany the agreement to bond at the time of submission?
- Response 2: No. See Response 1 above.
- Question 3: Can you please advise what the irrevocable period is for the above tender?
- Response 3: 30 Days as per Note 2 on Page 17 of 29.
- Question 4: Will the contractor be required to reinstall any line painting?
- Response 4: No, the Town is equipped to paint their own stop bars.
- Question 5: Sentence 1.21 in the RFP notes the liquidated damages as \$500/calendar day plus engineering fees and expenses (PDF page 10). Please confirm what the daily amount for the engineering fees and expenses will be.
- Response 5: This amount is completely dependant on the status of the works at the construction deadline set forth in the RFP. Therefore, engineering fees and expenses will vary based on this status and can not be pre-quantified.
- Question 6: Are the curb repairs associated with the catch basin and double catch basin modifications to be included in the unit cost for these repairs? (Items 2b), 3b), 4b), 5b).
- Response 6: Yes.
- Question 7: Regarding Items 2c) and 4c), how many sections / locations of curb replacements will be required for each item?
- Response 7: Item 2c): Two (2) section; Item 4c): One (1) section.

Question 8:

Items 2d) and 5c) note that HMA Padding may be required for correcting crossfall and profile prior to placing the surface course and that the contractor is to include this work in their unit price.

- a. Please clarify how the padding is to be quantified and paid for under these items?
- b. Would it be possible to provide how many tonnes of padding we are to include in these items?
- Response 8:

This Note is intended to ensure all road profile deficiencies are corrected, specifically within intersections, to guarantee positive crossfall and drainage to the CB's. Contractors are to satisfy themselves with any additional costs associated with HMA padding and include this cost within the item's unit prices.

Question 9:

Regarding Item 6 - Laneway paving, please clarify what (if anything) is required in terms of base preparation and grading prior to paving.

Response 9:

Contractors are not responsible for any base preparation. Contractors are to coordinate with Town of Shelburne Public Works Department of any concerns or recommendations prior to the date of paving to ensure quality finished product.

Questions 10: Also regarding Item 6 – Laneway paving, will the Town trim the overhanging trees along the laneway for equipment access?

Response 10: If deemed necessary, yes.
