# **BLACK HISTORY 365**



#### Black Heritage Stamps - Donated by Kaarina Dillabough from Amaranth Ontario

DCCBA is determined to celebrate Black History 365 days of the year and is very appreciative of Kaarina for sharing these stamps with us. Though the history is American, it is still a wonderful opportunity showcase the greatness of the black community.

James VanDerZee (1886-1983), American photographer who took thousands of photos of ordinary people and community groups, recording the emerging Harlem middle class. Sojourner Truth (1797-1883) American abolitionist and women's rights activist. Truth was born into slavery but escaped with her infant daughter to freedom in 1826. In 1828, she fought and won the case to retrieve her son and became the first black woman to win such a case.

Marian Anderson (February 27, 1897 – April 8, 1993) was an American contralto. She performed a wide range of music, from opera to spirituals. Anderson performed with renowned orchestras in major concert and recital venues throughout the United States and Europe between 1925 and 1965.'

**Dr. Allison Davis** (1932-1984) An anthropologist and educator, Dr. Allison Davis served the Johnson and Nixon administrations as a member of the President's Commission on Civil Rights and as the vice chairman of the Department of Labor's Commission on Manpower Retraining. He was a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the National Academy of Education.

# AUGUST 1, 2021 EMANCIPATION DAY

The Town of Shelburne and Dufferin County formally recognized Emancipation Day on August 1, 2021 with a proclamation for the first time. This came after a request to proclaim Emancipation day was submitted by DCCBA's president to both the Dufferin County Council and the Town of Shelburne.
