

On 5 July 1916, the Department of Defence and Militia authorized the formation of No. 2 Construction Battalion. It was the largest Black unit in Canadian history. These men conducted themselves with honour and professionalism in the face of prejudice, hate, and an unwillingness of other Canadians to serve shoulder to shoulder with them against a common enemy.

In March 2021, the Government of Canada stated its intent to issue a formal apology for the racism and discrimination endured by members of the No. 2 Construction Battalion before, during and after their service to Canada.
