This memo is being provided as an update from the Shelburne Heritage Committee regarding a current project in progress for the downtown core.

The Heritage Committee has been holding regular meetings and are in discussions with a local manufacturer to place heritage murals in two locations within the downtown core.

Currently the committee has funds held in a Heritage General reserve to accommodate funding the project.

The first location for installation of a mural is on the east side of the building located at 136 Main Street East (beside Jack Downing Park).

The second location is on the west side of the building located at 118 Main Street West (beside Jelly Lane).

Photos that have been selected by the committee are attached. The estimated install date is Spring 2022.
